- State has had 30 years to figure out a plan for keiki to continue from elementary into secondary education
 - This is the scraps and goes against the preference of Puohala makua
 - Mo'opuna and possibly beyond are still not going to experience
- Does the support of Kailua's principal indicate (albeit passively) a lack of support from Castle's principal?
- Not blaming po'o, but using him as a conduit to raise up our concerns and displeasure at this decision
 - As a year-1 principal, Ikaika is still learning and may not know all of the options available in this situation; he does not want to do a disservice
 - Po'o wants to start gathering input from makua Puohala
 - Concerns about retrofitting campus for k-12
 - Seems like a lack of understanding about kaiapuni behind this decision; leadership (CAS et al) treating kaiapuni like an English adjunct. Not actual reasons against having it in Kaneohe
- If you're going to have a ko'olaupoko kaiapuni, why would you insert into an English medium school? Equal at a minimum is to provide a standalone school for kaiapuni. Equity is even more
- If Kailua doesn't know what they're getting into, then someone is ignoring the legal rights of our keiki
- In terms of support, what do we need to start for #1 at Puohala, #2 at Castle?
 - What about a satellite school? Be under Castle until legally confirmed as a temporary arrangement. Use portapotties to bridge the bathroom gap
- Does Po'o support a full kaiapuni at Puohala? He's concerned about what happens to the English keiki, but he does support a M-12 kaiapuni
- Aunty Carol: When Puohala kaiapuni had 1000 keiki there used to be portapotty plumbing behind the last building in the mala.
 Always supported prek - 12 kula. Including ki'eki'e would just mean keeping the more mature keiki separate. It doesn't necessarily mean kicking the English keiki out of Puohala.
- Looking forward, we should look for a candidate for principal (long-term) maybe one that is home-grown and entrenched in this area
