- IV. Hope Pelekikena Daylin Heather
 - A. 'Imi Pono-fundraising event for Kaiapuni only, ALL community invited to attend and/or help. Keiki performances & fundraising. Vivian Wong, makua is coordinator this year. Talk story for a few minutes after meeting
 - B. Makua alakai papa
 - 1. Introduction
 - 2. Kuleana- connection between kumu, class parents, Hui Makua. Request that Makua Alakaʻi papa meet with all their parents face to face before next hālāwai to create pilina & to discuss with everyones thoughts on nīnau at bottom of contact sheet:
 - a) Why did you choose kaiapuni for your keiki/'ohana?
 - b) What do you want out of kaiapuni for your keiki/'ohana?
 - c) What, if any, are your concerns about sending your keiki to kaiapuni?
 - d) How can you help support kaiapuni? Your strengths? Connections through jobs/family?
- V. Treasurer Ardis Eschenberg/Lehua Coloma.
 - A. Motion to approve pre approved amounts & Table kumu supplies monies for later Daylin, 2nd kuulei.
 - B. Expenditures SY 2017-18 provided by Ardis Eschenberg, Treasurer.
 - C. Kumu preapproved amount tabled for next meeting- b/c kumu account balances unknown. Hui Makua wants to give up to \$500 per kumu for supplies. Need to know Kumu account balances. Po`okumu says she will provide account balances; school not required to give Hui Makua, therefore Hui Makua requested from Po`okumu & Kumu
 - D. \$8,583 went to school from Hui Makua last year. School has a fiscal year; Hui Makua is on a calendar year. It is best for Hui Makua to cut

checks to school because that is it's mission - needs to give majority of \$ to school. Makala prefers not to have Hui Makua donations run through school due tracking w/ SASA was flawed in past. Lehua will work with Kumu to help keep track of balances.

- E. Pre Approved budget is a budget ready to use up to the approved amount (ceiling) without having to vote on it at every meeting.

- VI. Kumu report Kumu Waianuhea Walk
 - A. Kumu Kalani (new) & Kumu Kamakani encouraged lei making activity w/ all the kumu kaiapuni. Each kumu chose a different kanu/pua to contribute. The Lei Piko is fastened over the top of entry to C building walkway, and represents how we are woven together in 'ōlelo Hawai'i. It's a reminder to 'ōlelo Hawai'i and Keiki can see it at wā oli.
 - B. Kumu Dukie has 22 keiki, majority new to olelo, ¼ from Punana Leo. Using Remind app to keep in touch
 - C. Kumu Kamalei is preparing for `Imi Pono. 6 new kids, new to language; Punohu helps in papa
 - D. Kumu Kulamanu requests 12 stretch bands for legs. UPDATE: Lehua spoke to Kumu Kula and she will be filling out funds request form
 - E. Kumu Waianuhea speakers at Punana Leo- Wed. Oct. 3 Kalei Laimana, Aunty Carol-- about the greatness of our kupuna. All welcome to attend. more info to come.
 - F. Kumu Kalani-teaching kids sign language, using mahalo/mihi circles to build pilina
 - G. Kumu Kaikaina papa 7 working w/ Kumu Aupuni books, pushing 'ōlelo Hawai'i
 - H. Kumu Kanoe, Kamakani, Kamalei taking teacher certification classes on either West side of island or online.
- VII. 'Aha Kau Leo Ka'ano'i Walk
 - A. AKL's purpose is to support Kaiapuni & focus on language revitalization & normalize olelo Hawaii
 - B. 8/25/18 Aha Kau Leo meeting in Manoa. UPDATE: cancelled due to Hurricane Lane

- VIII. Poʻokumu Report Makala Paʻakaula
 - A. Enrollment: HLIP 139. English 117.
 - B. Updates for papa 7 & moving Kaiapuni forward in Kāne'ohe. Papa 7: 6 keiki. Kumu 'Anela Texeira (makua & licensed teacher- BA) is the ELA (English Language Arts) kumu & guidance.
 - C. Papa 8 on track. Mahalo to Kauʻi Gerona (office clerk) who has been working hard to get things ready for intermediate school to go forward
 - D. Looking for a papa 8 kumu. OHE (Office of Hawaiian Education) giving 1 off ratio kumu for k-6, 1 additional kumu for intermediate.
 - E. Castle connection for 9th grade- Will need makua support for this. Papa 9 will be an entry level for new students to join kaiapuni.
 - F. Kaiapuni sub teachers we always are in need!! If we have enough persons interested in becoming a sub, makua included!... then Pookumu can hold a sub certification class. Don't need B.A., just high school diploma & interest in subbing Kaiapuni. Let Pookumu or HMOP know if you are interested. State still working on island wide list for kaiapuni subs.
 - G. Kaiapuni report card in progress
 - H. Uniform- looking at getting feedback from keiki & makua. VP & Pookumu will be reading w/ keiki regularly. Right now Mon is any college shirt. Fri is any 'ōlelo shirt or any puohala shirt (ie. huaka'i, black kaiapuni shirt, old green school shirt with old logo, etc). All other days is the puohala uniform shirt. This is clarification since something else was told to parents at Kindercamp & students at beginning of school year assembly. Makua voiced having a separate day to be only for 'ōlelo Hawai'i, since the school has been making an effort to normalize 'ōlelo on campus. Pookumu says will leave status quo for now. Only want 2 days non uniform days. She will accept feedback from families and students then will decide on changes, if any.. Black Kaiapuni shirt only allowed on Fridays!
 - I. 'Olelo hawaii Signage on campus- Want names on buildings w/ meaning/ significance to place. This will be discussed on Kupuna Mo`olelo night please come! Need volunteers! Need timelines! Suggestion-like KTA in Hilo QR reader thinking of incorporating that. UPDATE: Makiilei Ishihara to alaka'i 'Ōlelo Hawai'i Signage on campus. Mahalo!
 - J. Ultimate site meeting w/ mural scheduled with Kupuna Mo`olelo/Mural night, Thursday Sept. 6. !
 - K. English iReady testing papa 5 is part of curriculum & all students should be taking test. Papa 5 is year when English is introduced-1 hour per day. Pookumu says looking into English intervention during RTI (Response to Intervention) block or 1-2x week. Parent can opt out

of the tutoring or do it in RTI block (30 min) right after lunch. Math & hwn lang art, may be an option for after school intervention. Students shouldn't be told scores from iReady test. School needs to know their ELA (English Language Arts) level so they know level of each keiki & where to teach. Makua voiced concerns that papa 5 class has consistently been below grade level in 'ōlelo Hawai'i for years; Hawaiian language testing and tutoring should be main concern as opposed to introducing foreign language (English) testing at this point.

- HLL (Hawaiian Language Learner) Tutoring- for 1st grade and up - Pookumu requested feedback from kumu as to who needs. 1st priority-All brand new HLL. Kumu Anela Texeira will be kumu
- 2. Makua at meeting disapprove of English testing & voice that parents have right to decide on whether or not their keiki takes test.
- 3. English iReady testing discussion tabled & Pookumu will let us know a date to meet regarding Papa 5/6/7 english testing. Papa 7 must pass test for class credit or cannot move to the next grade level, i.e. Science, social studies, english, math papa 7.
