- IX. Update on letter from Hui Makua and response from CAS Matt Ho re reports of sexual assault (10 min) Daylin. Parents at meeting wanted to raise awareness & if any other keiki are affected, to come forward. Hui makua malama all makua & is here for all families & will work with administration.
- A. Sheena shared at Feb HMOP mtg.. Child witnessed inappropriate behavior at school. Incident happend in Dec. Wed before winter break. Incident had mental, social, psych effects on her keiki. Police involved. She had to reach out to pookumu 2 weeks after. Not sure what to do with this. Child fearful of going to school & perpetrator. Mahalo to HMOP for helping to support family. Wants help for all children affected and those that may have been exposed. We don't know who was exposed to this incident. It happened after school, at recess, multiple times. Did contact Pookumu & CAS Matt Ho w/ calls, but didn't get response. Asked HMOP for help. Hmop sent letter.
 - B. Celeste Keohokapu- with makua permission, HMOP shared letters they sent & received regarding the Dec. incident to HMOP listserve. 1) letter from. got phone call from office that there was incident w her son. Police called & were at school when she arrived. She was not told the full story. Sex assault 1st degree on police report. No reach out by admin. Came to school & was told pookumu was busy in Christmas party. Later received call. She was told kids are curious, boys probably enjoyed it.
 - C. Raina Pasatiempo-sat to talk w/ CAS & pookumu. Wrote to Matayoshi, CAS etc. Pookumu brushed her off & didn't help. She is pulling child out next

year because she's tired of fighting for basic ethics. Child's class was disruptive, rocks thrown in child's eyes.

- D. A Mom of another victimized child-pookumu gave info and offered counseling & checked up on her. She got multiple calls from pookumu. Was appreciative of pookumu's communication. Communication is very good w/ pookumu.
 - E. Kaipo-got a letter dec.20 saying there was an incident. But it didn't tell you what happened. Got letter saying someone came in to teach about sexual assault. Was not happy to hear news. But was happy w/ pookumu communication. She learned protocol was followed
 - F. English side of school didn't get letter.
