- **FIRST SATURDAY IN MARCH 2021!!!**
- Lots of Kōmike (committee) to join
 - Hawaiian plates, mea'inu, marketing, silent auction, donations
- Plans so far include doing something online and drive-thru
 - Drive-thru - Plate lunch, pick-up silent auction wins, pick-up sold goods from vendors
 - Online - Musical performances and honoring 30 people for 30 years of Ke kula kaiapuni 'o Pū'ōhala
 - Leinā'ala's nephew is providing 4 hrs of streaming services for free
 - Musicians would use their own online Venmo/Cash apps
 - Masks, t-shirts for anniversary commemoration
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- Po'okumu

- **SCC EVENT COMING UP ON DEC 1st 6PM.** Need lots of input & feedback so please contact Po'o Ikaika
- Keiki returning to kula for learning on campus. Starting small to test out procedures. KUMU should be reaching out. Tues/Thurs days to return.
- Academic Plans. Biggest gap is rotation to support teacher collaboration & meeting in-person, training, etc.
- Facilities - CALL/Kahea for 10x10 or 10x12 pop-up tents for KUMU/keiki to use during recesses. Expecting to use when rain/sun. Budget shortfalls are expected so trying to plan how to cover gaps like this or another example: power strips to charge multiple devices.

- 10% cut across the board minimum, even SPED
 - Plus 10% cut on services provided to the school
 - Po'o encourages questions or requests for him to cover at HMOP
 - No feedback/response from CAS Ho since our last HMOP so Leahua said she'll email all 3 (Ikaika, Matt Ho, Bernie @Castle) about kula ki'eki'e plans because interest is still strong. Ikaika has a meeting with Matt tomorrow.
 - Possible movie drive thru for Dec & Hope po'o Tracy offered to find out costs from the group that has been putting in on in Kailua.
- **Kumu**
 - Plans starting for a holiday festival. TBD. Don't want to cause confusion with details too early.

 - Big mahalo to all Mākua for their continued kāko'o to help keiki holomua & stay up with ha'awina. KUMU wouldn't be as successfully without everyone working together.
- **Treasurer - Leahua**
 - Report shown online in meeting. Recap of pre-approved budget as of last HMOP meeting. Total: \$14k + cookware (steamers) + HMOP Tent = \$17,350 approved.
 - No new request for monies so far.
 - No change to KUMU monies either.
 - MOTION by Ku'u lei for 5 pop-up tents (\$140/each up to \$700) to use for HMOP + KUMU or Kula needs. Kahea/Jenny seconded. More things happening outside, KUMU making plans to be outside as much as possible. Po'o asked to borrow 5.
 - Concern: Storing (HMOP container currently full. Not sure why) & tracking who has the tents.

- LOGO on Black Mask sample modeled by Lehua. Ear part not adjustable, but just tie with rubber band or knot to adjust for smaller. Lehua tried it on a mala'ao keiki

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- **Pelekikena**

- Brandi working to produce a letter on kula ki'eki'e support. Please contact Brandi to help with mana'o, legal advice, etc. Later, she will be putting out the kāhea to show support as requested by CAS Ho.
- Onboarding process for new kaiapuni 'Ohana
 - Putting together pamphlets and info to give to help & inform on rights
 - PO'OKUMU helped with what's already available so we can expand.
 - If you know of how other kula/kaiapuni do this process, have ideas or want to help, **contact Brandi.**
 - Need to reach out with a flyer (had one) to all the preschools in the area in the next few months to make them aware that Puohala is an option for mala'ao. WAIANUHEA will check (note: keiki on the flyer are now in 10th grade!)
- UPDATE ON getting Punana Leo back on campus from PO'OKUMU. Instead of doing a month to month facility request, an MOU should be done and connect with OHE. For now, since no one is back on campus, Punana is working on plans. Maybe back in January 2021.

 - MAKUA + KUMU can participate even if you're not the official AKL Rep/Delegate. Ka'ano'i will send the info to HMOP to email out to everyone.
