 - Concerns:
 - h.s. Transcripts counting towards college
 - Comparison with non-Kaipuni students (b/c in a model like Kahuku, the English teacher gets all 9th grade)
 - Activities are English-centered; social life
 - Maybe try for dual-accreditation (UH, WCC, BYUH?)
 - ◆ UH just started a BAND (BA + Masters + Teacher Cert) in 5 years; Hawaiian language/studies
 - AKL feedback:

- Concern over the small volume of kaiapuni graduates and diversifying into further careers
- Learning
- Castle-Kahuku Complex Community Budget Meeting coming up
 - 3/12/21 10AM-11AM

- Any plans for next SY to keep any DL for 'ohana who want to attend Pū'ōhala but might not physically be able to drive to kula daily
 - Tentatively looks like another year is likely for 100% DL
